General projects and activities:

**Physical Activity Promotion at parks/schools (up to 2 LA Works members)**

Activities: Work with afterschool programs and summer camps to assess physical activity opportunities (at school and home) and work with kids to create a family plan (that includes activities kids want to do with their families)- ties into options outside of school/parks/sustainability

**Advancing mommy postcard project (1 LA Works Member)**

Activities: continue the work from previous interns where postpartum postcards were created to focus on the mom (create prenatal ones as well), these postcards were focused on mommy wellness and proposed ways for moms to increase her social support system as well as high-fives (encouragement). Work with MCAH, BIH and WIC to incorporate the postcards into their curriculum, counseling, mailings to highlight women's health and wellness.

**Medi-Cal enrollment and redetermination outreach (up to 2 LA Works members)**

Activities: outreach at community events and conduct door-knocking in neighborhoods where there is a higher probability of residents eligible for medi-cal but who are either underinsured or uninsured. Team will use technology developed for Lead Free Homes to note their efforts, track resident engagements, and document number of referrals to medi-cal enrollment teams such as the CHOEUR program at PPHD, Covered CA at ChapCare, and other health insurance resources. The team will also support public messaging through social media and collaboration with other community resource centers.
