Two Part-Time AmeriCorps volunteers will help with food distribution on Fridays during our Supplemental Food Program. One Full-Time and one Part-Time AmeriCorps volunteers will help with the expansion of our Supplemental Food Program to include food distribution on Saturdays. Another Full-Time AmeriCorps Volunteer will serve in our Community Farm.

In addition to adding a Saturday food distribution, Corps members will be involved in increasing community engagement for our community farm. Members will work to create workshops and volunteer opportunities for members of our community.
