


Design your book template anyway you would like. You can draw a picture or a symbol that relates to something you love in the book—it could be a main character, an exciting scene, or a symbol that represents something in the book.

You may do a **written review** that we will scan so it can be shared with students <u>or</u> you may complete a **video review** by using the same guidelines. <u>You can also do both!</u> Since kids will be using reviews to choose a book, videos are easy for them to view quickly and encouraged.

When you design your review, **please include the following** information:

- What did you think about this book? (without giving away the whole book)
- What is your favorite part of the book?
- Describe the characters and setting.
- State one reason why students should choose this book?
